CAC MEETING MINUTES APRIL 11, 2023

The meeting was called to order by Chair Judy Jones.

In the staff report, Brad reported on bus stop improvements throughout the county, and is asking members to get back to Skagit Transit if they note any bus stops that may need any corrections or attention. John stated a service change notice should be posted in the Burlington Senior Center.

Regarding route frequency recommendations, the route 207 that services the YMCA was mentioned by Valerie, and Brad stated there are going to be modifications to the roads and intersection, making for safer access. Similar improvements will be made to other bus routes as well, with the coming route changes.

In other reporting, it is noted that Former CEO Dale Obrien is officially retired, with a party given in his honor.

Cheryl reported that all Skagit Transit employees participated in the annual blood drive earlier this month through Bloodworks Northwest.

For the round table section, there was some discussion on the CAC web site.
